3. I agree that I will not sue or make a claim against Rokka Ski School, Rokka Ski Club, Rokka Ski Lodge, Boyne USA Inc., or any of its owners, officers, agents, or subsidiaries, including but not limited to, Ski Lifts Inc., Crystal Mountain, Inc., Alterra Mountain Company; and the U. S. Preliminary COVID-19 Protocol 2022-2023

Help keep our community safe and healthy while having fun on the slopes! Below is the preliminary 2022-2023 COVID-19 Protocol. We ask for your cooperation in complying with requirements.

The Rokka COVID-19 Advisory Committee will monitor the local COVID-19 situation and may update information in this document accordingly. In addition to Rokka's protocol, all participants must follow the protocol at Summit at Snoqualmie (found [here](#)) and provided by state and local governmental agencies.

General Rules:

- All students and staff must show proof of vaccination on the first day of lessons (January 8th, 2023). Additional booster shots for those that are eligible are optional but recommended. Fully vaccinated students include those who have received:
 - 2 doses of Moderna or Pfizer
 - 1 dose of Johnson & Johnson with a booster shot
- The Rokka Chalet will remain closed to students and families before, during, and after class. We will only gather and take breaks outside the Rokka Chalet.
- Wearing a mask is recommended, especially when inside or in close vicinity of others.
 - For more information about CDC recommended masks please visit the [CDC's Guidance for Wearing Masks page](#).
- Surgical masks, hand sanitizer, and water bottles for students will be available outside of the Rokka Chalet.

Rules that are Subject to Change:

- Masks may become required depending on case counts in the greater Seattle area and based on local regulation and guidance at the time of lessons.
- Booster vaccinations may become required in accordance with any updates to recommendations from the CDC or local officials.
- Hot chocolate will only be provided outside the Rokka Chalet if current case counts are acceptably low.

Vaccination Verification Process:

- Acceptable proof of vaccination includes CDC vaccination card (front and back), or WA State Immunization certificate. Digital verification can be downloaded at <https://waverify.doh.wa.gov/>.
- All vaccinated students will present their proof of vaccination to their instructor to verify on the first day of lessons (January 8th, 2023).

六花 COVID-19 諮問委員会は、周辺地域の COVID-19 感染状況を注視し、状況に応じてこの記載事項に関連する情報を更新して参ります。六花の対策に加えて、スキーレッスンに参加する皆さま全員がスノコルミーサミットスキー場(ここを[クリック](#))と政府機関の指示に従う必要がありますのでご注意ください。

一般規則:

- 生徒さん及びスタッフ全員が講習初日(2023年1月8日)にワクチン接種証明を提示する必要があります。追加のブースター接種は任意ですが、接種資格のある方は追加接種をお勧め致します。以下の接種を済ませることで、接種完了と致します。
 - モデルナまたはファイザーを2回接種
 - ジョンソン&ジョンソンを1回接種し、更にブースター接種を完了
- 講習前後および講習中に、生徒さん、保護者の方は、六花スクールの施設内には立ち入れません。クラスの集合、休息は六花の校舎の外にて行います。
- マスク着用を推奨いたします。特に他の施設内または隣接区域では着用をお願い致します。
 - 失病予防管理センター(CDC)推奨のマスクに関する詳細は、[CDC's Guidance for Wearing Masks page](#) をご覧ください。
- 外科用マスク、消毒液、ペットボトルは六花校舎の外にて生徒さんにご用意致します。

変更が予想される規則:

- 講習期間中にシアトル圏内での感染者数の増加、政府機関の指示によってマスクが必要となる場合もあります。
- CDC または政府機関の指示にしたがって、ブースター接種が必要となることも考えられます。
